Dear my fellow Hmong brothers and sisters:

It's been forty years ago that our leaders and our parents brought us to this great nation. We have been through trauma and grief, unimaginable experience as refugee and endured the hardship as we're rebuilding our life in a new land. Knowing what we've been through, I find it hard for me to find a proper way to asking members of our community to make any more sacrifice, not to mention asking for financial contribution but I guess we all do.

However, today I am writing to you to asking you for your financial support as we are engaged in a fight to seek justice for our people against genocide, ethnic cleansing, and human rights violations against our people in Laos by the Lao PDR governments as witness in the documentary "Hunted Like Animals" by Rebecca Sommer, reported by Amnesty International, by the Department of State of the United States of America, by International News Networks such as BBC, Radio Free Asia, Le Monde 2 and other respective news outlets around the world.

In the past forty years, many of our leaders and members of our community have tried to resolve this atrocity against our people in Laos peacefully with the Lao PDR governments without solution. Now we are engaged in a fight to seek justice for our people as our International Human Rights representative has filed our case against the Lao PDR governments to the United Nations Human Right Councils in Geneva on September 8, 2015.

We may not be able to erase the suffered of our people from the rape, torture, mutilation, disembowelments, and poisoning, killing, starvation at the hands of the Lao PDR governments. But we will make sure the Lao PDR government is held accountable for the war crimes they committed against our people for the last forty years, and to make sure the world never forget the Lao PDR governments for what they have done to our people and our children, and to continue to protect our people and our right as a people, and our dignity as a member of the human race for years to come.
